

The Higher Council for Scientific Research (<u>CSIC</u>) will hold a tribute to Professor **Javier A. Abadía Bayona**, who died on November 18th, 2022. The act is scheduled on **February 17th** from 10:00 to 13:00h in the Rioja Hall of the Ibercaja space Patio de la Infanta (16 San Ignacio de Loyola St., **Zaragoza**, Spain).

Javier Abadía, an Aragonese researcher internationally recognised for his work on plant nutrition, worked for 40 years at the Aula Dei Experimental Station (<u>EEAD</u>), which houses agricultural research of the <u>CSIC</u> in Aragon.

The event is organized by the Institutional Delegation of the <u>CSIC</u> in Aragón and the EEAD-CSIC, together with the <u>Plant Stress Physiology</u> group, founded by the professor in 1988 and led by him for 35 years.

Elena Cartea González, Deputy Vice President of Scientific-Technical Areas of the CSIC, María Jesús Lázaro Elorri, Institutional Delegate of the CSIC in Aragón, and Jorge Álvaro Fuentes, Director of the EEAD-CSIC, will open a program that will include the participation of doctoral students, disciples, national and international collaborators and colleagues of Javier Abadía, who will provide personal details in his memory and tribute. The Plant Stress Physiology group members will give an overview of the scientific career of their leader. The event will conclude with a brief cello concert by Dolores Miravete Martínez.
