

The Higher Council for Scientific Research (<u>CSIC</u>) held a tribute to Professor **Javier A. Abadía Bayona**, on **February 17th** in the Rioja Hall of the Ibercaja space Patio de la Infanta (16 San Ignacio de Loyola St., **Zaragoza**, Spain).

Professor Javier Abadía passed on November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022, after having worked for 41 years at the Aula Dei Experimental Station (<u>EEAD-CSIC</u>). About 150 people attended the moving ceremony, organized by the Institutional Delegation of the <u>CSIC</u> in Aragón and the <u>EEAD</u>, together with the Plant Stress Physiology Group, founded by the professor in 1988. Elena Cartea González, Deputy Vice President of Scientific-Technical Areas of the CSIC, María Jesús Lázaro Elorri, Institutional Delegate of the CSIC in Aragón, and Jorge Álvaro Fuentes, Director of the EEAD-CSIC, opened a <u>program</u> that included the participation of doctoral students, disciples, national and international collaborators and colleagues of Javier Abadía, who provided personal details in his memory and tribute. The group members gave an overview of the scientific career of their leader. The event concluded with a brief cello concert by Dolores Miravete Martínez.
